MINISTRY HOURS

What is ministry? Ministry comes from the Latin word for “service”. Therefore, the students may perform virtually any type of service for another person or persons. The only stipulation is that the service be done outside the student’s home and without payment to the student. If they are paid, the money may be donated to the church or another charity.

The “Ministry Hours” may include but are not limited to the following: raking a neighbor’s yard, snow removal, visiting an elderly person (relative or not), in a nursing home (by him/herself). Christmas caroling, etc.

The “Ministry Hours” exclude those chores that the student would normally be expected to do at home (e.g.) cleaning his/her room, babysitting, household chores, etc.)

If you are unclear about what is included or excluded please speak to Pastor for approval of the ministry in advance.

The number of ministry projects performed for the required number of hours does not matter – it can be one or a hundred.

The “Ministry Hours” report will need to be completed and returned to the student’s teacher upon completion of each ministry. The report forms are available from the teachers or in the bottom row of the mailboxes.

“Ministry Hours” required:

First year students must complete 8 hours.

Second year students must complete 12 hours.
